Invite letters sent out  
with appointment

Health Advisor will call

Telephone triage  
assessment conducted  
by Inhealth Health  
Advisors

If a patient is assessed as high  
risk on the telephone  
assessment a face to face  
Lung Health Check conducted  
by Nurses on mobile unit
