


CT screening saves lives!

- UNITED KINGDOM LUNG CANCER COALITION
- **➤ Continue to push for expedited roll out across England**
 - concern about slipping behind 100% by 2030
 - need to see a clear commitment in the National Cancer Plan
- **➤ Support Welsh Government with their roll out plans**
- **▶** Persuade Scottish Government to expedite their plans
- **➤ Support NI clinicians lobbying their administration**



Genomic testing





> Testing improving but remains variable across UK

>Affects up to 30,000 lung patients p.a.

- ➤ Waits of up to 4 weeks still commonplace
- >UKLCC call of 14 days from biopsy to full results

Access to optimal care for all




- >13 400 deaths p.a. linked to deprivation
- ➤ Incidence of lung cancer 2x higher in many deprived areas compared to least deprived
- > Equity of access to complex care for all
 - > Increasing disparities with increasingly complex treatments
 - > Reduce variation in standard of care
- > Focus on rural and coastal communities



Focus on survivorship



- > Rapid increase in numbers of long-term survivors
 - Post surgical or radiotherapy
 - Systemic therapies controlling disease
- ➤ Survivors are at increased risk of developing second primary lung cancer
- **▶1** in 8 will develop second primary lung cancer
- ➤ Risk for SPLC in never smokers is similar to eversmokers
- **►** Increased focus on holistic care of long-term survivors
 - > Recognition of and support for mental health

- ➤ Historically challenging to match; changing in many ways
- ➤ Clinical Expert Group has given some guidance on numbers
- ➤ Some areas particularly stretched; radiology; pathology; genomics; CNS
- **▶** Embracing new approaches to working AI and education
- **→** Getting right people doing the right job
- > Pathway navigators are emerging and evolving
